

Position **6 x COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS**

The Walvis Bay Corridor Group (WBCG) and Ministry of Health and Social Services (MHSS), in collaboration with the USAID-funded Data for Implementation (Data.FI) project, will be conducting the third Key Populations Integrated Bio-Behavioural Surveillance Survey in Namibia (KP IBBS3). The goal of the KP IBBS3 is to estimate the burden of HIV and HIV-related disease; assess health service utilization and progress towards reaching the 95-95-95 UNAIDS target; and estimate the population size of key populations. The study will collect data in five sites in Namibia: Engela, Katima Mulilo, Lüderitz, Walvis Bay/Swakopmund and Windhoek. The survey will be conducted using respondent driven sampling (RDS) methodology, to reach the intended populations.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Community Health Workers will be responsible for conducting survey based HIV Testing Services and related interventions in partnership with the KP led organizations in the respective project sites.

- Perform HIV pre-and post-test counselling and other rapid diagnostic tests in line with the relevant national standard procedures and guidelines as and when required,
- Support the implementation of the survey in terms of HIV self-testing and effective linkage of clients to treatment, care and support services.
- Organizing and facilitating advocacy and demand creation sessions for the survey
- To ensure appropriate referrals as per the national health systems.
- To provide ongoing supportive counselling to clients, their partners and family members.

REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Education and Professional Requirements:

- Must posses a Grade 12 or Grade 10 Certificate.
- MoHSS Valid Accreditation for HIV Rapid Testing and Counseling.
- At least three (3) years demonstrated experience in the HIV and AIDS field (Experience in working with key populations will be an added advantage).
- Must have basic or advanced computer skills.
- Must be a Namibian citizen.
- Members of the key population community are encouraged to apply
- A valid driver's license (C1 license will be an advantage)
- Fluent in English and local languages of the region is a distinct advantage.
- Oral and written fluency in English, including good report writing skills.
- Ability to maintain professional confidentiality all time.
